## JR FLAMES



The Quad City Jr. Flames have just two wins in their first eight games. On some teams, that would require pressing of the panic button, but not in Quad City where the Jr. Flames know it's still early in the season to worry about much.

Second-year forward Josh Prygon said the team might still be feeling itself out. "Our team is gelling well together," Prygon said. "We have noticed that we are getting better each week in practice, but lack the team effort during game time. We are working well together, but need to develop more team chemistry."

Even with the 2-6-0 start, Prygon knows there is a long road ahead and is taking it upon himself, along with some of the other older players on the squad, to turn Quad City around and boost the team up the CSHL standings. "I realize as a veteran on this team that we need to step up the leadership and show our new players what it takes to win in this league."

The Jr. Flames' two wins came two weekends ago at home against Metro. In the second game of the series, goaltender David Jacobson pitched a 25-save shutout in a 6-0 win.

Veteran defenseman Jerry Rank, also Quad City's captain, has been steady on the back end and is a respected leader on and off the ice. "Jerry Rank is the heart and soul of our team," said Eberline. "Everyone listens to what Jerry has to say. He is a great leader."
