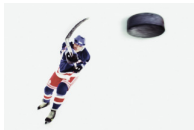

Summer hockey starts week of July 21 for Termite to Middle School (register on line for all above). This will be 3 on 3 hockey. If you are 18 or over and do not have Level 1 certification, helping out with this program is one way to get your certification and also provide the much needed support. ### **Quad Cities Sports Acceleration**

Quad Cities Sports Acceleration (QCSA) will be opening soon at the River's Edge. This location will provide on-site dry-land training available to our various hockey programs. QCSA is aimed at improving strength, power, agility, quickness, flexibility and conditioning – all important elements for enhancing hockey player performance. Various programs will be offered including speed and power development in four, six, or eight week programs with two sessions per week. Sport-specific programs, with the same duration and weekly frequency will also be available. Strength training programs in eight, twelve, or sixteen week sessions will also be offered, tailored to sport-specific needs. Pre-adolescent (ages nine – twelve), and adolescent (ages twelve - fourteen) will be provided as well.
